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5830 STUDENT FUND RAISING

The Board of Education will limit the solicitation of funds by and from the students of this district in order to protect students from unnecessary pressures and the instructional program from disruption.

"Student fund raising" means the solicitation and collection of money by students, on or off school premises, for any purpose associated directly or indirectly with the school district or under circumstances in which the solicitors are identified as students of this district.

Students may solicit and collect money for approved school organizations, provided the Superintendent or designee has approved the fundraising.

No fund raising activity involving door to door solicitation shall be permitted.

The Board prohibits any fund raising activity that includes incentive awarded to students through which the student may earn a prize or be given other remuneration for raising funds.

Students may solicit and collect money on behalf of nonschool organizations, provided the Superintendent or designee has approved the fundraising.

No student will be permitted to solicit and collect money on school premises or at a schoolsponsored event for the student's own benefit.
